98c Grant Proposal Plan to Address Learning Loss Academy of Warren

Programming:

Academy of Warren plans to use the 98c Learning Loss Grant to implement a Multi-tiered Support System (MTSS) program in an effort to mitigate learning loss. The program entails identifying students who are not proficient in the areas of reading and math and targeting those deficiencies. The NWEA assessment will be administered to all students in September. The data will then be analyzed to determine the students with academic needs. Interventions by trained professionals will take place on 3 levels.

Tier 1 Interventions:

Classroom teachers will use the Waggle program from HMH to support students with deficiencies in both reading and math.

Tier 2 Interventions:

Paraprofessionals will work with teachers to provide more individualized instruction that meet the direct needs of the students. This will include more time with the intervention program. NWEA Data will be utilized by Interventionists to provide services.

Tier 3 Interventions:

Reading and math specialists will pull students from the classroom and offer additional support by working with them in small groups using an adaptive learning technology, (i.e. Dreambox, Freckle). NWEA Data will be utilized by Interventionists to provide services.

Students seeking additional support will be offered the same opportunities during after school tutoring and throughout the summer.

Implementation Timeline: The MTSS program will begin in October of 2022 and will continue through August of 2023.

Metrics used to evaluate the program:

NWEA assessments and Houghton Mifflin and Harcourt assessments

Estimated costs:

NWEA - \$12,000 Interventionists (ELA & Math) - \$22,000 After School Tutoring/part-time paraprofessionals - \$4,492
